FINISHED SIZE

4½ inches square

MATERIALS

- Size 10 crochet cotton: 70 yds white
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

10 sts and chs = 1 inch; 4 rows = $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches

PATTERN NOTE

Chain-5 at beginning of rows counts as first treble crochet and chain-1 space.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Beginning cluster (beg cl): Ch 3, *yo twice, insert hook in first st, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, rep from *, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.

Cluster (cl): Yo twice, insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, *yo twice, insert hook in same st, yo, pull lp through, [yo pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, rep from *, yo, pull through all 4 lps on hook.

Picot: Ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

DOILY

Row 1: Ch 29, *yo twice, insert hook in 5th ch from hook, yo, pull lp through, [yo pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, rep from *, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook (*first cl*), [ch 1, sk next ch, tr in next ch, ch 1, sk next ch, cl (*see*



Special Stitches) in next ch] across, turn. (7 cls, 6 tr, 12 ch-1 sps)

Row 2: Ch 5 (see Pattern Note), cl in next tr, ch 1, tr in next cl, [ch 1, cl in next tr, ch 1, tr in next cl] across, turn. (7 tr, 6 cls)

Row 3: Beg cl (*see Special Stitches*), [ch 1, tr in next cl, ch 1, cl in next tr] 6 times, turn. (7 *cls*, 6 *tr*)

Rows 4–7: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] twice.

Rnd 8: Now working in rnds, for border, ch 1, sc in each st and in each sp across with 3 sc in last st, [3 sc in end of each of next 2 rows, 4 sc in end of next row] twice, 3 sc in end of next row, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, 3 sc in first ch, sc in each worked ch and in each ch sp across with 3 sc in last ch, [3 sc in end of each of next 2 rows, 4 sc in end of next row] twice, 3 sc in end of next row, 2 sc in same st as first sc, join with sl st in beg sc. (104 sc)

Rnd 9: Beg cl, [ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 3, sk next st, cl in next st] 6 times, *ch 3, sc in next corner st, ch 3, cl in next st, [ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 3, sk next st, cl in next st] 6 times, rep from * twice, ch 3, sc in next corner st, ch 2, join with sc in top of beg cl (counts as joining ch sp).

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in joining ch sp, picot (see Special Stitches), ch 1, [sc in next ch sp, picot, ch 1] around, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off. ■

FINISHED SIZE

43/4 inches across

MATERIALS

- Size 10 crochet cotton: 50 yds ecru
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

Rnds $1-4 = 2\frac{1}{4}$ inches across

PATTERN NOTES

Join with a slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of rounds counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCH

Picot: Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

DOILY

Rnd 1: Ch 5, **join** (see Pattern Notes) in beg ch to form ring, **ch 3** (see Pattern Notes), 15 dc in ring, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (16 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 4, [dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 4] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (16 dc, 8 ch sps)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 5, sk next ch sp] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.



Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next st, *ch 3, sc around next 2 chs on last 2 rnds at same time, ch 3**, dc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in next st, *ch 5, sk next ch sp, tr in next sc, ch 5, sk next ch sp**, dc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in next st, *ch 5, sk next ch sp, 2 dc in next tr, ch 5, sk next ch sp**, dc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in next st, *ch 3, sc around next 2 chs on last 2 rnds at same time, ch 3**, dc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first st, *picot (see Special Stitch), sc in next st, ch 6, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, ch 3, sk next sc**, sc in next dc, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join in beg sc. Fasten off.■

FINISHED SIZE

4½ inches across

MATERIALS

- Size 10 crochet cotton: 75 yds white
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

Rnds $1-3 = 1\frac{1}{2}$ inches across

PATTERN NOTES

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of rounds counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-4 at beginning of rounds counts as first treble crochet unless otherwise stated.

INSTRUCTIONS

DOILY

Rnd 1: Ch 5, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg



ch to form ring, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), 9 dc in ring, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (10 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch-2 sp), [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5. (10 dc, 10 ch-2 sps)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 4 dc in first ch-2 sp, 5 dc in each ch-2 sp around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (50 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 4 (see Pattern Notes), sk next 3 sts, [tr in next st, ch 5, tr in next st, sk next 3 sts] around to last st, tr in last st, ch 5, join in 4th ch of beg ch-4. (20 tr)

Rnd 5: Sl st in next st, (sl st, ch 3, 9 dc) in next ch sp, 10 dc in each ch sp around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (100 dc)

Rnd 6: Ch 4, sk next 3 sts, tr in next st, ch 5, tr in next st, [sk next 3 sts, tr in next st, ch 5, tr in next st] 18 times, sk next 3 sts, tr in last st, ch 5, join in 4th ch of beg ch-4. (40 tr, 20 ch-5 sps)

Rnd 7: SI st in next st, (sI st, ch 3, 9 dc) in next ch sp, 10 dc in each ch sp around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. ■



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
