MATERIALS LIST

Bavarian Headband

Materials

- Cascade Fixation (light worsted) weight cotton/elastic yarn (1¾ oz/100yds/ 50g per ball):
1 ball each #5104 aqua and #8176 cream
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



Bavarian Stripes Scarf

Materials

- Omega Sinfonia light (light worsted) weight cotton yarn (3½ oz/218 yds/100g per ball):
1 ball each #811 rose, #802 cream, #807 khaki and #804 coffee
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



Wintry Cloche & Neck Warmer

Materials

- Plymouth Encore Tweed medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool/rayon yarn (3 oz/200 yds/100g per ball):
1 ball each #T599 dark brown, #T461 grape jam, #1237 granola and #5539 pink
- Size J/10/6mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Stitch marker
- 1¼-inch buttons: 4
- Matching sewing thread



Bavarian Wrap

Materials

- Plymouth Encore DK light (light worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (1¾ oz/ 150 yds/50g per ball):
6 [8] balls #389 greyfrost mix
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



Mini Bunny Cuddle-Up

Materials

- Euro Baby Babe light (light worsted) weight nylon/acrylic yarn (1¾ oz/180yds/ 50g per ball):
1 ball each #32 sand, #6 ivory and #1 white
- Sizes E/4/3.5mm and F/5/3.75mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker
- Fiberfill



Baby Crop Cardigan

Materials

- Plymouth Dreambaby DK light (light worsted) weight acrylic/nylon yarn (1¾ oz/ 183 yds/50g per ball):
1 ball each #0305 happy spots, #0142 eggcream and #0143 lima bean
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- ¾-inch white button
- Matching sewing thread
