## MATERIALS LIST

### Stripy Cowl & Slouchy Cap



#### Materials

- Berroco Vintage (worsted weight; 52% acrylic/40% wool/8% nylon; 217 yds/100g per hank): 1 hank each fuchsia #51176 (A), fennel #5175 (B), lilacs #5183 (C) and breezeway #5194 (D)
- Size 5 (3.75mm) 24-inch circular needle
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 16- and 24-inch circular and double-point needles (set of 4) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size G/6 (4mm) crochet hook
- Stitch markers, 1 in different color for beg of rnd

### Stripes-in- the-Making Bag



#### Materials

- Berroco Vintage (worsted weight; 52% acrylic/40% wool/8% nylon; 217 yds/100g per hank): 1 hank each fennel #5175 (A), breezeway #5194 (B) and fuchsia #51176 (C)
- Size 5 (3.75mm) straight and 36-inch circular needles and spare circular needle
- Size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers

### Upright Stripes Shawlette



#### Materials

- Berroco Vintage (worsted weight; 52% acrylic/40% wool/8% nylon; 217 yds/100g per hank): 1 hank each lilacs #5183 (A), fennel #5175 (B), fuchsia #51176 (C) and breezeway #5194 (D)
- Size 5 (3.5mm) 29-inch circular needle (for borders)
- Size 7 (4.5mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge
