Six-Pointed Star Sampler Quilt

Materials

- ⅛ yard each light 1, light 2, light medium 1, light medium 3, medium 1, medium 3, medium dark 4*
- ¼ yard each large print 1, large print 3, light medium 2, medium 2, medium 4, medium dark 1, medium dark 2, medium dark 3, dark 2, dark 3, dark 4*
- ⅓ yard each large print 2, dark 1*
- ½ yard dark 5*
- ⅝ yard light medium 4*
- ¾ yard medium dark 6*
- 1⅛ yards light 3*
- 1½ yards medium dark 5*
- Backing to size*
- Batting to size*
- Thread*
- 8-inch or 10-inch Clearview Triangle™ 60-degree ruler or 8½-inch Creative Grids® 60-degree ruler
- Qtools Sewing Edge, Cutting Edge, Corner Cut 60 and On The Dot Repositionable Markers (optional but highly recommended)
- Master Piece Static Sticker or Clear Self-Adhesive Paper (optional but highly recommended)
- Basic sewing tools and supplies
