Materials

- 1 fat quarter each yellow, dark blue and light blue*
 - ½ yard needle-punched insulating batting
 - 9" square cotton batting
 - Thread
 - Paper-piecing pattern material
 - Open-toe embroidery presser foot
 - Even-feed or walking presser foot
 - Creasing tool
 - Add-A-Quarter™ ruler*
 - 6½" square ruler (optional)
 - Tweezers
 - Basic sewing tools and supplies

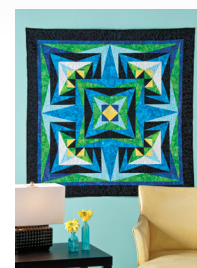
Autumn Splendor Table Topper



Materials

- ⅛ yard dark yellow green
 - ¼ yard each bright royal, dark green
 - ⅜ yard tan
 - 1 yard dark mauve
 - Batting to size
 - Thread
 - Paper-piecing pattern material
 - Creasing tool
 - Open-toe embroidery presser foot
 - Even-feed or walking foot
 - Add-A-Quarter™ ruler*
 - Tweezers
 - Basic sewing tools and supplies

Four-Point Compass Quilt



Materials

- ¼ yard yellow
 - ½ yard white
 - 1 yard each medium and light blue
 - 1¼ yards green
 - 1½ yards dark blue
 - 2 yards black
 - Backing to size
 - Batting to size
 - Thread
 - Paper-piecing pattern material
 - Open-toe embroidery presser foot
 - Even-feed or walking foot
 - Creasing tool
 - Add-A-Quarter™ ruler*
 - 12½" square trimming ruler (optional)
 - Tweezers
 - Scotch tape
 - Basic sewing tools and supplies
